MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING [MOU]


FOR PROMOTION OF EDUCATION FOR THE EMPOWERMENT OF THE PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

The Memorandum of Understanding between Yashwantrao Chavhan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik Dnyangangotri, Near Gangapur Dam, Govardhan, Nashik - 422 222, Maharashtra [acronymed as YCMOU hereafter] and Rehabilitation Council of India, a Statutory Body under the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, B-22, Qutub Institutional Area, New Delhi-110 016 [acronymed as RCI hereafter] is signed herewith on the 15 Sept. 2012 by the Registrar on behalf of the YCMOU and RCI agree to collaboration in promoting education for the empowerment of the persons with disability and will abide by the following provisions to achieve the desired goals

- 1) YCMOU and RCI will make joint efforts in promoting and implementing education programme for the empowerment of special target of persons with disabilities within the jurisdiction of YCMOU.
- 2) YCMOU will collaborate with RCI in programme design and development of multimedia for the distance mode Special Education Programme and will facilitate delivery and certification of such programmes.
- 3) RCI recognizes YCMOU as State University equipped for undertaking Special Education and Rehabilitation Programmes through Distance Mode and in regional language (Marathi). RCI will also extend technical expertise to YCMOU and its Study Centres.
- 4) YCMOU and RCI will launch / implement Bachelor of Education in Special Education [B.ED. Special Education] Programme and Post Graduate Professional Diploma in Special Education [PGPD in Special Education] covering the basic skills in Education including basic components for all major disabilities specified in the RCI Act.
- 5) For existing programmes, the faculty and infrastructural facility at the University, academic contents, eligibility conditions and process of evaluation will be the same as prescribed by the RCI. However, YCMOU in consultation with RCI could propose new programmes which could be designed by team of experts appointed by RCI with two expert nominees of the YCMOU.
- 6) The academic contents, eligibility conditions, design development and delivery of programmes will be separately worked out by the Rehabilitation Council of India and YCMOU for each programme as and when required.
- 7) The translation of the contents of B.ED.[SEDE] Programme of RCI will be done by a team of experts appointed by YCMOU in Marathi language. The content will be vetted by the experts appointed by RCI.
- 8) All the education programmes under operation or to be operated in future need to be planned a Transparent, Self-Financing and Self-Sustaining Schemes with generation of fund through Programme Fees to meet the running cost of the programme which includes.
  - a. Implementation cost of the implementing agencies Study Centre and YCMOU.
  - b. 10% of the Programme Fee for distance education project of the Council covering staff promotion, maintenance of quality and research etc., as RCI share and
  - c. Generation of development cost to the extent possible for recycling the amount as seed money for future development is essential for continuous quality improvement. The amount of the Programme Fee is to be fixed in consultation with RCI to meet the above financial implications for self financing.





- 9) On the basis of the criteria in Article 8, the Programme Fees will be shared by the YCMOU, the RCI and the Study Centre[s] on PRO-RATA basis as per the norms fixed for each Programme as per need. The norm of sharing Programme Fees should be fixed by RCI in consultation with Open Universities on a long term perspective.
- 10) The responsibility of development and generation of self-learning course material in print, audio-video [including talking book] format etc., will be of YCMOU. Approved material will be supplied by YCMOU to institution[s] and students as per the requirement. However, the panel of experts will be identified jointly by YCMOU and RCI.
- 11) The selection of the study centers for conducting the programme will be done by RCI in consultation with YCMOU.
- 12) The YCMOU will monitor the programme of each approved Study Centers.
- 13) RCI and YCMOU will jointly decide the norms for identification of study centres, the honorarium to the Counsellor, details about the system of evaluation and admission. However, 75% attendance in practice teaching in recognized schools/centres and counseling session will be compulsory for the Teacher Trainees to be eligible to appear in the term end examination.
- 14) There will be an Apex Advisory Committee which will normally meet twice a year to oversee the implementation of the MOU. The Committee will consist of the following.

- 15) The MOU will be valid for a period of 5 years but could be renewed from time to time at 5 years interval. However, it could be terminated earlier by either party giving notice of one academic session.

Dr.Sanjivani Mahale , I/C Director, School of Education YCMOU of Education YCMOU welcomed the dignitaries and outlined the objectives of the meeting.

Dr. Kavita Salunke, Spl B.Ed. Project In- charge presented the structure of the course and the Present Position of the SIM, which was developed by YCMOU

Dr. Subodh Kumar pointed out that as per new syllabus & rules; YCMOU is required to make the change in duration of the course and also the eligibility criteria. Dr. Salunke prepared the revised structure note (which is approved by RCI member Secretary next day.) attached in app.

The major discussion and decisions



- \* Marathi SIM, which was developed by YCMOU for Spl. B.Ed. Program, should be revised as per RCI's new syllabus up to August end.
- \* implementation strategy, evaluation mechanism and procedure should developed as per RCI's new Norms (2015) and Regulations for B.Ed. Spl. Ed (ODI)
- \* University should appoint at least one separate Senior/Junior Research consultant (Academic) for Spl. Education for smooth implementation of the course. Hon V.C. of YCMOU approved this suggestion immediately. (Project In-charge prepared the advertisement in consultation of Dr. Subhod Kumar next day. Attached in app. 2)
- \* Pilot testing is not needed. First batch in all over Maharashtra of the said course should be implemented from the academic session Sept or Dec. 2015 - 2016  
The Duration of the course will be Minimum 2.5 year as per RCI's new norms. So the semesters will be as follows  
Dec. 2015 - May 2015  
June 2016 - Nov 2016  
Dec. 2016 - May 2017  
June. 2017 - Nov 2017  
Dec. 2017 - May 2018
- \* University should invite the Proposals for the Study Centers of the said Program through advertisement in July 2015. Enlist the study centers and submit to RCI for recognition. These centers should preferably be established and recognized by RCI, New Delhi. (As per the suggestion, Project In-charge of Spl. B.Ed. had prepared the advertisement with consultation of Dr. Subhod Kumar and finalized it, Attached in app no 3.)
- \* University should organize training program for co-coordinators and counselors of the study centers. The qualifications and experience of these persons shall be as per the norms laid by RCI.
- \* YCMOU can enroll maximum 500 students per batch, 50 per study center.
- \* The fees for the course decided by the YCMOU is Rs 7000/- per semester. Thus total fees of Rs 35,000/- will be charged. From the total fees 50% amount will be given to YCMOU, 40% amount to study center and 10% amount to RCI.
- \* Decided Plan of Action.
