

Environment Study (EVS 101)

Practical No 1:

Contact a volunteer engaged in the movement of environment protection in your area. Interview him/her on the following points and write a report of the interview in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Name of the volunteer and name of the organization.
2. Activities undertaken by the organization to create awareness about environment, medium used to create this awareness.
3. What efforts does the organization make to get contribution of college students, housewives, citizens in environment protection?
4. Information about the specific movement that the organization undertook to protect environment in your area.
5. What problems does the organization face with regard to participation of local people in the movement and generation of funds?

Practical No 2:

Visit a Public Park run by the Municipal Corporation in your city, area. Interview the manager of the park on the basis of the following points. Write a report of the interview in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Name of the Public Park and year of establishment.
2. Management committee of the park, members and total employees of the park.
3. Total number of trees in the park and their medicinal use.
4. Arrangement of water and protection of trees and animals from man and animal to trees.
5. Budget of the park.
6. Total number of visitors on an average daily.
7. Efforts made by the park management about environment protection and creating awareness about it.
8. Manager's view about the importance of public park in our day to day life and how people can be motivated to visit the park regularly.

Practical No 3:

Visit the industrial area in your city. Interview the families living around and nearby area and collect information from them on the following points. Write a report of the interview in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Name of the industrial area and industries mainly situated in the area, types of products etc.
2. Problems faced by the people living in the area because of air and sound pollution generated by the industries like soaring of eyes, hearing loss. Problems faced particularly by women, children.
3. Steps taken by the local administration to combat pollution and its effectiveness.
4. Measures adopted by the industries to combat pollution and purify air water caused by them.

Practical No 4.

Visit the river and nearby area in your area. Study how due to increasing urbanization and population, river water is polluted. Take Photography through your mobile. Collect information from the people living in nearby area due to this pollution and instruct them as to how they should not pollute the river water. Mention in your report as to how you to made them aware of the fact and convince them. Write your report in 30 to 35 lines. Attach photographs.

Practical No 5.

The local newspapers create awareness among people about environment protection. They create this awareness by way of publishing articles, news depicting problems of environment in the area, publishing speeches by environmentalists etc. Prepare a report on the basis of such awareness creates by the local news papers on the basis of following points.

1. Name of the selected newspaper duration of selection like last two months/ a month.
2. Importance given by newspaper for creating awareness about environment protection like number of news, articles published, interviews of environmentalists, their lectures and dealing with a particular problem of environment in local area. Collect photographs, news cuttings of lectures published in news paper and prepare a report.

Practical No 6:

Visit a local Higher Secondary School in your area and interview the headmaster of the school in order to know what activities the school conducts in order to create awareness in students about environment protection. Prepare the report on the basis of following points. Write your report in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Name of the school, society and name of headmaster.
2. Name of the teacher who teaches environment science in the school.
3. List of the activities conducted in the last year and during the year.
4. List of the experts who have delivered lectures about environment protection.
5. List of audio-video media available with the school and audio and video programs about environment protection.
6. Expectations of school from the students, parents and local people to support their efforts in environment protection.

Practical No 7:

Contact the Forest Officer in your area and interview him on the following points. Prepare a report of your interview in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Total Forest area.
2. Names and types of trees available in forest and their importance.
3. Number and types of animals.
4. Precaution being taken for protection of the forest.
5. Problems being faced by the forest officer and staff like breaking out of fire, theft of forest products, cutting down of trees etc.
6. Laws of forest protection.

Practical No 8:

Interview the local Traffic Police inspector in your area on the following points. Write your report in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Extent of pollution due to vehicles in the area.
2. Norms prescribed by the traffic rules for minimum emissions of smoke and actions taken if there is more emission of smoke by vehicles.
3. Problems faced by traffic police and their staff due to vehicular pollution.
4. Precautions to be taken by the motorists', two wheeler drivers to minimize pollution.
5. Percentage of air and sound pollution official statistics published in the last week.

Practical No 9:

Visit an old temple or historical monument in your area. Observe the effects that have taken place due to air, water and sound pollution on that historical monument. Prepare your report in 25 to 30 lines on the following points.

1. Name of temple or monument.
2. Area, its nature and historical background. Causes responsible for pollution in the area like industries, slum area encroachment etc.
3. Nature of damages caused by the pollution like breaking of steps, fading of color, damage to the original structure.
4. Efforts being done by the local body for protection and maintenance of the monument like maintenance of cleanliness, appointment of regular staff, financial provision, enforcement of law and action taken against those who cause damages to monument.
5. Precautions being taken for protection of the monument.

Practical No 10.

Today there are many TV channels which create awareness and emphasize the need to protect environment and the bad effects caused by pollution. Select a channel and such a program prepared on environmental problem. Watch the program carefully and prepare a report on the following points. Write your report in 30 to 35 lines.

1. Name of the channel, name of the program, date and time of relay.
2. Problem handled in program, area, types of pollution, impact of pollution on local people and intensity of problem.
3. Problems faced by people due to pollution which have been expressed by them in program.
4. Opinions of experts and remedies suggested by them.
5. Your own opinion about the problem presented through channel.
